2. GLOBAL EVIDENCE SYNTHESIS

- a. Global commission on evidence syntheses after the pandemic, including lessons learned and what do they tell us about the evidence synthesis community post-COVID (see attachment 3)
 - < Background to the global commission:
 - Important to have more people from the demand side than the supply side, so this is not seen as the evidence synthesis community indicating the need for more resources, but rather having influential players from the demand side signalling that evidence synthesis is a core component of how we view the world in the future
 - The proposal includes convening a commission of key thought leaders globally and articulate in a document the important of evidence synthesis. Articulate the need from the demand and facilitation side, but what we can do on the supply side as well in terms of building on the existing institutions and strengthening them (e.g. broaden opportunities for strengthening of registration for PROSPERO)
 - Might be able to do something alongside the World Health Assembly next year (2022)
